Welcome to the first newsletter of the year. This is a slash and burn newsletter with some bargains you won't believe possible. As hard as it may seem to believe major label country just keeps getting worse. There are still some vestiges of quality on the major labels but they are ignored by the radio programmers. Dwight's latest was a return to Reprise but sold only 75,000 copies as radio programmers deemed it too country to play. Ditto Jamey Johnson's wonderful Hank Cochran tribute. Sold poorly. It seems that there are so many guided by what the mainstream radio plays that they are too dim to vary their buying habits and embrace the true stuff. Again I like to think of Yesterday & Today Records as some kind of alternate universe where the true fans are rewarded. Early in the year, releases tend to be of fairly low volume but there have been some absolute stunners, including favourite Amber Digby.

2012 Albums of the Year

- 1) Tim Culpepper "Pourin' Whiskey on Pain" \$28** If we had such a thing as a People's Choice award this would also be the winner...so maybe can be a dual winner. The album owes more than a nod to Mark Chesnutt's classic "Too Cold at Home" and that is not a bad thing. Better even is that they are all original songs, mainly written by Elbert West, who wasn't bad in his own right but Tim is a vastly superior singer. Not one bad track. Personal favourite is "One More for the Road". Some may say a steal of the song "Too Cold at Home"...but even if it is, I don't care!! Even with all the plaudits it was hard to favour it over any other album in the top 10.
- 2) James Hand "Mighty Lonesome Man" \$28** The classic traditional vocalist lives. Very much in the same school as Norman Wade & Vernon Oxford, and hard to

believe this is his best album yet. The song, "Old man Henry" is my song of the year. A very Jone-ish delivery on this but honestly George at his prime could not have bettered this original version. Wonderful.

- 3) **Eric Strickland & The B Sides "Honky Tonk Till I Die" \$25** There is nothing like an album of honky tonk songs performed superbly with a couple of modern day truckin' classics thrown in for good measure. There is a hidden track, assumably called "Drinkin' Whiskey"...why they do this is beyond me but no mark down as it is great. "Haggard & Hell" is a gem!!
 - 4) **Blake & Kendall Barnes "Welcome to Barnes Country" \$20** Such exuberance. He is the wonderful honky tonk singer and she shows all the enthusiasm and style of Brenda Lee. Only 2 in stock at this price.
 - 5) **Wesley Dennis "Country Enough" \$25** Hard to Believe this is only his 3rd album.
 - 6) **Dottie Jack "Lighter Shade of Blue" \$28** as wonderful as her previous gems , also on the revitalised Hillside label. If you were speaking of Dottie, along with Amber & Miss Leslie, in racing parlance there would be a short half head between them. They are that good.
 - 7) **David Ferguson "David Ferguson" \$20** This wonderful tribute to Cowboy Jack Clement is something everyone should have. Sadly, Cowboy Jack is in a very poor health state. He has liver cancer, diabetes and Alzheimer's. The wonderful album is a fitting tribute. David Ferguson sounds incredibly like Cowboy.
 - 8) **Kelly Spinks "Right Out Of This World" \$28** Again, hard to believe this is only Kelly Spinks' third. Wonderful voice like Beaumont natives George Jones & Mark Chesnutt and a fine mix of originals and covers. In the latter category none is better than Stoney Edwards' "Two Dollar Toy"
 - 9) **Joey & Rory "His & Hers" \$20** The perfect pair. Limited to copies on hand
 - 10) **Chuck Cusimano "I Wrote This" \$20** Hard to believe he is not more widely known. Limited to copies on hand
- Honourable mention Sweethearts of the Rodeo "Restless" \$28 and Teea Goans "That's Just Me" \$28**

Amber Digby: The World You're Living In, Heart Of Texas Records HOTR4606:

Yes, Duncan Warwick is correct (**note..Country Music People reviewer/editor**). This is actually the best album so far on Heart of Texas Records. It is actually better than last year's Tony Booth album, and that was the best that far. When I heard the first track I thought that I heard the song of the year, but when I heard #7 it was even better. After that there were 2 more contenders for song of the year, namely #9 and #13. This album

is just unbelievably good. I would say that there are 3 trax that are just good; the rest of them are superb or better. The last track is a steel guitar instrumental and it is excellent as such. I cannot imagine that we will get anything better this year. The album of the year is already decided. **I will add that Amber has added a new string to her bow and that is as songwriter. Despite the aversion for the Nashville style she has been to Nashville and written with several major writers. This includes Vince Gill and their co-write, "One More Thing I Wished I'd Said" is superb. Yep, Amber sings a female version of "The key" Whilst there they also cut a duet together, "The One I Can't Live Without". She was on Mark Chesnutt's last and now Vince. I would dare say both enjoyed their experience. Wonderful album. Yes, her best. Shades "Music from the Honky Tonks" by virtue of the quality of her original songs.**

Dale Watson & His Lonestars: "El Rancho Azul" , Red House Records \$28: Dale has made a lot of excellent CD:s through the years (and several that are just good but not excellent) and could be called one of the biggest country stars of the last 20 odd years, but he still struggles to maintain a proper 5-piece band and obviously sells moderate numbers of albums. There is no justice in country music. However, this CD is probably one of his very best. It is up there with his 3 Hightone ones and Dreamland. It is just superb. Only original songs, and damn good ones at that! A great mix of mainly up tempo songs, shuffles and waltzes! Great singer and backing! **Would echo these sentiments. Dale for mine has been producing even more consistent albums than he did at Hightone. This is the first in a little while. He did do some of the songs when he appeared here a couple of years ago and they went over a treat.**

Wayne Hancock: "Ride" Bloodshot \$25 And Wayne The Train also comes up with an excellent album. This one is in exactly the same style as his earlier ones; country boogie and early 50's style country. All the songs seem to be original and the backing is spot on. What is a bit surprising is that he calls out for Johnny before every guitar solo when there is no musician listed with the name John or Johnny. Excellent! **Might add that Bob Stafford is wonderful both on guitar & trombone. Trombone is an integral part of Wayne The Trains' best albums and gives wonderful light and shade. Wayne has been in a Betty Ford style establishment and now says he is a "Double A Daddy". Don't worry his music is superb.**

VA: "Unsung Hero, A Tribute to The Music of Ron Davies" Little Chickadee \$30 Who is Ron Davies was the first thing I thought when I saw this disc. Well, it turns out he is Gail Davies' brother and a song writer; a dead one at that. I cannot remember ever hearing of him, so he is no hero of mine, but evidently of Gail Davies who has taken on the task of producing a tribute to her dead brother. This is a long album, but far from everything is worth listening to. The Delbert McClinton song is OK and others worth listening to are the ones by BR549, Suzy Bogguss, Rodney Crowell, Jeff Hanna and John Prine. Other notables include John Anderson, Robbie Fulks and Dolly Parton. This is mainly folk music and a few rock songs with a bit of country here and there. With 22 trax everybody should be able to find something to listen to here, but most of it isn't my taste. **Now, this is the part where the Cowboy has the axe in his hand...so take note more of the summary. I will add that Gail Davies is a super talented lady AND was responsible for producing what is arguably the best ever tribute cd in "Caught in the Webb" so you know she is talented. The songs are not as immediate but I like them. Some of the participants that the SC disn't mention are Vince Gill (with Kelly Hogan), Guy Clark, Alison Krauss and Mandy Barnett. They could gargle dishwater and it would be better than anything Taylor Swift or Kenny Chesney is ever likely to do**

Chris Wall: "El Western Motel" \$25: This is singer-songwriter music, and I think that as such is it good. This has some steel, dobro and mandolin here and there, but the guitar and fiddle dominate. The good thing here is that the songs are not slow, but all

have good tempi. Also the lyrics are excellent and he is a good singer. **This is all new material by Chris and features the wonderful Lloyd Maines. Its is recorded live in the studio. This is his first in at least 10 years I would say. Any disillusionment with the music industry is not evident. His story telling is sublime. "Six Shiny Strings" tells of the changing lives and fortunes of a guitar. "Hello I'm an Old Country Song" is a cowrite with Dale Watson so you know it is good.**

That's it for the Swedish Cowboy...thanks mate!! Rest are 100% mine.

Everly Brothers – "The Ballads of The Everly Brothers" \$32

Everly Brothers – "Rock" \$32

Two new Bear Family releases and to be honest there is sometimes not a lot of difference between the two...I mean "Johnny is a joker...he's a bird" is not that far removed from "Dream...dream dream dream..." they have the great harmonies and an energy that is fabulous and hard to not find totally infectious. Each has 30 tracks and as always the Bear Family quality is hard to resist. On the ballad one in particular it is not only a case of what you hear but what you don't hear....this is particular in evidence on tracks such as "Like Strangers"...wonderful recording and reproduced perfectly.

George Hamilton IV & George Hamilton V 'Texas Cowboy Church" \$25 The father & son do a nice mix of traditional and non traditional songs of which "Bargain Basement Preacher" is excellent. Don't know how it fits in with the theme but they also include a joint version of George's theme song "Abilene".

Joni Harms "Harm's Way" \$25 Joni made one album for a major label and it was fine but as an independent artist she has stamped herself as a Western Tunessmith, to snitch the title of a great Chris Ledoux album. This keeps up the standard with both production and quality of the material. She wrote all the songs and several with the delightfully named Hobo J Varsos. "Love Won't Get No Where" is a wonderful country song that could have been taken off an Amber Digby or Miss Leslie album. Great.

Ronnie Miller "Brothers, Legends & Friends" \$25 Ronnie is a steel guitar player and was the Steel Guitar Association's "Player of the Year" for 2011. There are some vocal guests...Charley Pride (he is Charley's steel man), Daryle Singletary and Vince Gill. The album is dedicated to John Hughey, famed as Conway's guitarist and a member of the Time Jumpers and includes a Conway Medley as well as a Charley Pride medley.

Poco "All Fired Up" \$28 This is the first studio album in over a decade and still at the forefront, and seemingly over a health scare is Rusty Young, on steel guitar and vocals. The group has now been going 45 years "Regret" sounds like a classic Eagles song...former Poco man Timothy B Schmitt became a member of The Eagles. They show a humorous side with a great song and parody..."Neil Young".

Bobby Bare "The Real Thing/ I Hate Goodbyes-Ride Me Down Easy" Omni 2 on 1 \$28 These are very hard to get albums, particularly the first which was released prior to Bare going to Mercury for a brief period. The second was made on his return and features the Billy Joe Shaver title song. Tom T Hall is responsible for 3 of the songs on this cd. His observations on "Chicago Story" are right there with his classics. Eddie Noack's "Barbara Joy" is the stuff classic country is made of...where else would the singer be a death row inmate? Excellent value with 24 tracks.

Gerald Smith "Hits & More" \$25 You won't find this anywhere. He is a writer whose probably greatest success has been Lorrie Morgan's "What Part of No" which for mine is the best thing Lorrie has ever done. Now, he does a version here and you are going to say, no doubt, the lyrics of that song are entirely from a female perspective. Well, Gerald ties it together nicely....he is sitting in the bar and he tells of the overheard

conversation...which started "Sir if you don't mind I'd rather be alone". He also did one of the best of the later George Jones songs "The Lone Ranger"...about the guy who had so many silver bullets!! He also does his version of the witty "you Sing Like Chet" which appeared on the recent Clinton Gregory album...a wonderful cd which due to an ordering error can be yours for a song. He also has penned songs for George Strait and Collin Raye and as you may expect covers a number of styles. He is excellent on teh upbeat honky tonkers. Great.

Whiskey Sisters "Whiskey Sisters" \$28 They were voted Best new Band in the Austin South By South West music awards and have an energy that is not really traditional country. You'd probably have to go back to 90s Carlene Carter for a comparison. They have taken up a spot at the Continental Club, an Austin mainstay. The female honky tonker "Let's Drink" is as country as you could get, with references to Merle Haggard even, but elements of blues mix perfectly with country on tracks such as "Home on the Highway". The vocals are great. They harmonise and trade leads and despite the title "Fool" are definitely nobody's (fool that us). Top drawer.

Bob Manning "All Night Radio" \$28 Bob Manning and his wife Kimberley Murray are already ensconced as part of Yesterday & Today Records country music royalty. Bob's previous album "Just What I Wanted" was our album of the year 2 years ago and the new one sounds just as good. It is dedicated to the golden era of country radio, reminiscent of what all night radio legends such as Bill Mack used to play. It features 14 new songs. "Making Up With Her" features the wonderful Tony Booth as duet partner. "Rosita", written by Kimberley Murray has all the subtle vocal nuances that show Bob as the classic vocalist he is. Just in by seconds...rest assured it is going to be here till the end of the year. Very attractively packaged as well.

Vern Gosdin "40 Years of the Voice" 4cd box set \$55 This features 101 songs from the voice. It is in a very attractive fold out package and has a 16 page booklet. The songs really give a fine overview of Vern's career. It also includes 11 new songs which are: Coldest Bedroom/ Dixie's on My Mind/ Joy to the World/ Let's Get Down to Business/ Likes of Jesus Loving me/ Mont Eagle/ Rockabye Katie/ Santa's Driving a Chevrolet This Year/ That Old Silver Tone/ The Biggest Little Arms/ What's a Country Coming To. The set begins (chronologically) with some of the bluegrass oriented songs he recorded with his late brother Rex and highlights his great success on the Columbia label. Sadly no longer with us but what greater legacy than to be remembered simply as "The Voice".

Others

Teresa Brewer "A Sweet Old fashioned Girl' 2cds Jasmine \$30

Teresa Brewer "Miss Versatility" 2cds Jasmine \$30

There has been more than a severe shortage of Teresa Brewer material on the market..there has been nothing. These will change that with 62 tracks and 61 tracks respectively. She fell into the category of pop singer with enough versatility to cover country...she does a great version for example of ET's "Walking the Floor Over You". The hits are evenly distributed on both albums. Sadly she passed away in 2007 so I guess her final regret may have been the dearth of her classics. At least that has changed now.

Ronnie Ronalde "The Voice & Whistling of Ronnie Ronalde: By Popular Demand' EMI UK \$28 Ronnie was a product of the English music halls but enjoyed great success in Australia where yodelling was not something frowned on but rather widely embraced. This is an EMI UK release which features 50 tracks and appropriately starts with Don Robertson's "The Happy Whistler". They cover the period 1949 to 1970. He is still kicking in his 80s and apparently still performs.

Frank Ifield "The Yodelling Cowboy Years" Jasmine \$28 In case someone missed it when first out, this is Frank's early country recordings prior to his pop

stardom in the UK..he was such a star that the first Beatles album released in teh USA was called "Frank Ifield & the Beatles"..the company thought the Ifield songs may tempt buyers into trying the music of this hitherto unknown group!! True. 31 tracks

Yodelling Slim Clark "Cowboy & Yodel Songs" \$28

"Singin' Yodelin' Guitar Pickin' Cowboy Songs" \$30 Back in stock..the second was a big success end of last year. The earlier one had 28 songs on it.

Other Recent Bear Family.

Eddie Noack "Gentlemen Prefer Blondes" 3cds \$70 Classic Starday and other label honky tonk. Later in the year Bear will issue a second Noack cd with his version of "Psycho" on it.

Paul Anka "Dianacally Yours" \$32 36 of his early recordings including "Diana" (honestly the title of this cd stinks!), "Lonely Boy" "Put Your Head on My Shoulder" etc

Louis Prima "Louis Rocks'" \$32 30 of the best with Sam Butera and Keely Smith.

Sun Country Box 6 cds + large hardcover book \$240 ...as a bonus I have found a copy of the book that went with the original lp version many years ago so will chuck that in.

Johnny Cash "The Unseen Johnny Cash" \$40. What we get is a 12 x 12 hard bound book of studio photos taken of Johnny between 1955 and 1958 that have never been published before. PLUS a one sided lp of two transcription shows...on lp for the first time. The other side of the lp (not playable) has etchings of Johnny Cash....so get it and you'll be able to use th lie come up and see my etchings.

Porter Wagoner "Cold Hard Facts of Life" \$70 ...not recent but back in stock. His classic themed RCA albums (6 of them) on one package.

Ernest Tubb "Walking the Floor Over You: Ernest Tubb Shows Part I" \$35

Ernest Tubb "Walking the Floor Over You: Ernest Tubb Shows Part II" \$35

These are DVDS featuring Ernest Tubb and the Texas Troubadours in fabulous colour from mid 60s. The Troubadours Jack Greene & Cal Smith do solo spots and a short hair suited Willie Nelson guests on both".

UK Reissues...due soon. Most on cd for the first time. Don't miss out.

1. Marty Robbins "El Paso City/ Adios Amigo" 2 on 1 \$30 Two albums from 1976 and 1977 respectively, teh former continuing his El Paso thread.
2. Roy Drusky "In a New Dimension/ If the Whole World Stopped Lovin" 2 on 1 \$30 Two mid 60s albums that are going to be the only Roy Drusky available. Never heard it but "Mr Jones I Want to Marry Your Wife" is a delightful title.

3. **Ray Price** "San Antonio Rose/ Night Life" 2 on 1 \$30 Ray Price at perhaps his artistic peak. The second is always reckoned to be one of the greatest country albums ever and set the tone for his later recordings. He is still as good as it gets. The former is a tribute to Bob Wills. The latter is just a must.
4. **George Jones** "Jones Country/ You've Still Got a Place in My Heart" 2 on 1 \$30 Two of George's early 1980s albums on cd for the first time.
5. **Mac Davis** "Hard to Be Humble: The Best Of" \$30 At least the first great Mac Davis cd with the wonderfully witty title song & 21 others . Includes his great writing on "Watching Scotty Grow", "In the Ghetto", "Something's Burning" etc
6. **Marty Robbins** "The Legend/ Come Back to Me" \$30 Marty's final albums from 1981 and 1982. Still singing as good as ever and great songs. Featured the fabulous Jordinaires.
7. **Louvin Brothers** "The Christian Life: the Definitive" Proper Box \$35 4 cds + booklet in the nifty little Proper box. 112 tracks. A must have if you don't have the Bear Family box.
8. **Jessi Colter** "Miriam/ That's the Way A Cowboy Rocks & Rolls/ Ridin' Shotgun" 3 lps on 2 cds \$30...Jessi's final 3 Capitol albums all on cd for the first time
9. **Glen Campbell** "Glen Travis Campbell/ I Knew Jesus/ I Remember Hank Williams" 3 on 2 \$30

Berry, Benny Standing Here Alone \$45

Berry, Benny Mama's Rockin' Chair \$40

Down to one copy only of each and only two titles. People have taste.

Hawk Records from Northern Ireland was the company that released Oklahoman Benny's first 4 albums. Everyone who was a Merle Haggard fan loved Benny. He had a similar timbre in his voice and was ably backed by a team led by Mike Headrick, a picture of whom is hung on the Swedish Cowboy's wall and to whom the (highly religious) Swedish Cowboy says a prayer of thanks every night. Benny also is the recipient of our greatest **EVER** independent artist award. Others may disagree but they are entitled to be wrong. Every one of these is nothing less than brilliant, especially for fans of Merle Haggard. Had a few of each but solitary copies now. I can still remember palying "Standing Here Alone" for the first time

Bond, Johnny Best of Johnny Bond \$35 17 tracks on Varese & the only place you will get the original "Hot Rod Lincoln". Also the hilarious "Ten Little Bottles".

Boone, Larry Swingin' Doors & Sawdust Floors \$35 As good as it gets. A great songwriter & singer he reminds of George Strait in the late 80s! This was his second cd and includes two songs written by Larry that are synonymous with other artists. "Beyond the Blue Neon" is of course the title song of George Strait's best ever album whilst "Old Coyote Town" is a Don Williams' specialty. Two great Texas songs (both originals)...the honky tonker "Ten Times Texas" and "Under a Lone Star Moon" (the great ballad) complete this gem.

Dalton, Lacy J – Crazy Love \$35 Capitol, followup to "Survivor" and right up there with it. Highlight is "Little Boy Blue" a song Lacy wrote about her own song and a wonderful ballad that suits her husky voice. Great title track, a cover of an excellent Van Morrison song

Davis, Joey "Love Songs, Waltz's True Stories & Lies" \$35 The spelling may be a bit out but 17 superb honky tonk tracks are as good as it can go. "Barroom Hall of Fame" may be the best. Everybody loves this album. This has been voted as one of the Top 10 indie albums of all time. Like all true honky tonkers Joey is an all rounder...drinking, lying and cheating. Just superb.

Delray, Martin Get Rhythm \$35 This is absolutely one of the best albums we have ever had and whilst the title track features Johnny Cash joining Martin in a sensational duet, I have no reservations in saying Martin's version of the Wood Newton song "Lily's White Lies" is one of my favourites of all time. A delicious play on words brilliantly performed by Martin who got fed up with the music industry. Only 2 albums but as talented an artist as I have ever heard.

Dickens, Little Jimmy I'm Little But I'm Loud \$35 22 track gem on Razor & Tie is now out of print. Whilst it covers all his styles from honky tonk to novelty it includes one of the best ever tearjerkers, maybe the best, in "Raggedy Ann"...you sure have been quite a doll Raggedy Ann, yes quite a doll. Love the angst filled ballads. Great artist still performing.

Edwards, Stoney "Old Folks Stick Together" \$40 Razor & Tie. A stunning compilation of his Capitol tracks including "A Two Dollar Tou"...the closest he ever got to a hit "Hank & Lefty Raised My Country Soul", his stunning take on "Mississippi You've Been on My Mind" etc. What a voice! Lefty, Hag and Stoney!! Don't miss it.

Flatlanders "One More Road" (Charly UK) \$40 Butch Hancock, Joe Ely and Jimmie Dale Gilmore...3 Texans who recorded an album of great significance that was never released until Charly in the UK did so. It contains classics such as "Dallas" and "Tonight I Think I'm Gonna Go Downtown" and the sound is stunning. Rounder in the US released this with 4 tracks less and to get all 17 you need this. I do believe the sound is better here as well. For mine a unique album with Steve Wesson on musical saw being a standout!! You better believe it.

Ford, Tennessee Ernie & Glen Campbell "Ernie Sings & Glen Picks \$35 This is the original issue with full liner notes by country music authority Rich Kienzle.. A 1975 album which has Ernie singing over Glen's acoustic guitar. The simple arrangements highlight Ernie's wonderful baritone and his interpretation of 2 Kristofferson songs, "Nobody Wins" & "Loving Her Was Easier" showed he could sing anything.

Ford, Tennessee Ernie "Capitol Collectors Series" \$35 Wonderful 29 tracker with great liner notes and sound quality. I have said it before, this series (ie Capitol Collectors) is all out of print but always represented the best sampling of an artist's work. They have the ones you want to hear and also include stunning obscure tracks such as Ernie's take on an R & B number "I Don't Know". Ernie was one of the most versatile country vocalists who is revered for his gospel and religious recordings. There is only one such example here, but what a beauty..."His Hands".

Gaddis, Ron Chip Off the Old Block \$40 Ron was for many years the bandleader for George Jones and he was the guy who duetted with George on live versions of "No Show Jones". He was also the first husband of Lorrie Morgan; now that is a lot of water under the bridge story. Obviously there was no lasting acrimony as Lorrie joins him on "All Day All Night Thing", a great song. The all out honky tonker "I Fell Off the Wagon" features his former boss, The Possum himself and Porter Wagoner joins on "When the Shiny Silver Eagle meets the Great Speckled Bird". As you might expect there is more than a little George Jones influence. Hard to believe this is Ron's lone album, A superb one too. Latest info is that alas Ron has followed the path of his mentor.

Haggard, Merle The Way I Am \$35 His MCA gem is literally like trying to find gold. Features some of his best and most personal songs like "No One to Sing For But the Band" & "Life's Just not the Way it Used to Be" Also has a mini tribute to Ernest Tubb with 4 tracks either written by or associated with the Texas Troubadour. Great album.

Haggard, Merle "Friend in California" \$40 Original copy of this great album on the Epic label which includes his answer song "The Okie From Muskogee's Coming Home". He does a superb cover of Floyd Tillman's classic "This Cold War With You". A must.

Husky, Ferlin "Capitol Collectors Series" \$40 This series is simply the best quality as far as sound and notes go.. This gem contains Ferlin's wonderful "The Waltz You Saved for Me", plus some hits and non hits. Well annotated and attractively presented.

Jackson, Larry Blue Highway \$40 (Loree label) I don't think I have ever had a song like Larry's "The Blue Highway" to attract a question as to who is it?? Larry's voice I would suggest has been weathered to perfection. He is a superb singer and writer but alas these are his only two albums. You feel he has lived the songs. The sad "When Love Dies" has a real ache to it. He has real angst in his voice when he sings "Damn Those Memories". Up there with the greatest indie cds ever

Jackson, Larry "Out of the Blue" \$45 This second album even has an uptempo honky tonk belter "Honky Tonk Two Steppin' Beer Drinkin' Saturday Night" & what better way to show his great voice than with a definitive reading of the Paul Siebel classic "Louise". Alas, it seems zero chance of another album. Have heard rumours of Larry's demise but nothing to support it...hope it is not true as there is one place he is appreciated to the extent he should be.

Jansen, Frank You're a Phone Call I Need to Make \$40 (Bob Grady)

Jansen, Frank My Way or the Highway \$35 (Pink Records)

Staggeringly great albums, the first on the wonderful Bob Grady label with production from Mike Headrick (the Swedish Cowboy will NOT go to bed at night unless he has said a prayer of thanks under the mounted 8 x 10 signed Mike Headrick photograph that hangs proudly in his living room) . I know there are several who rate the title song of the first as one of the greatest album tracks ever, and I am not going to argue. Most of the tracks on the first are by Bob Grady whilst Frank proves himself a writer of the highest standard on the second. He is also a brilliant interpreter. On the first he does a wonderful version of Dwight Yoakam's "The Heart That You Own". Am I going to suggest Frank does it better than Dwight...yep, I am.

Jones, George Live at Dancetown USA \$40 Amazing album superbly recorded which was on Ace UK label but has been deleted 10 years or so, 26 tracks and over an hour running time and in great stereo sound. Like the Ernest Tubb below (also from 1965!) this is amazing and George runs through things he has written ("Window Up Above"/ "Ragged But Right"/ "Accidentally on Purpose") as well as songs by Dickey Lee ("She Thinks I Still Care") Harlan Howard, Melba Montgomery etc. Although not a regular "Jones boy" Buddy Emmons joins the band for this set. Also Don Adams (not Max Smart!) acts as the leader of the Jones' Boys & duets with George on Melba Montgomery's "We Must Have Been Out Of Our Mind" as well as a couple of his own leads. Just remembered the classic Jones' line "We're gonna take a short liquor-mission I mean intermission"!!

Jones, George Alone Again/Grand Tour \$35 2 on 1. "Alone Again" is only available here & is rated one of his very best albums.

Martin, Mario Keep it on the Country Side \$30 Produced by James Stroud the amazing thing is that Mario was only 17 at the time. I still think about how this could be his only album. A 17 year old is so darn convincing when he sings honky tonk songs. How could that be.. I don't know. Still as stunning and as perplexing (in the sense of where is he now??) Favourite track is probably "Another Nail in the Wall"...very reminiscent of Ricky Van Shelton. A stunning album.

Martin, Tony I'll Meet You in Texas \$25 1996 gem on the Bob Grady label produced by Mike Headrick. A very Haggard/Bakersfield influenced cd. What makes this so great is that it features 9 new Whitey Shafer songs, many co-written with Lonnie Williams who also writes one with Roger Springer.

Mata, Billy Made in Texas \$35 A real favourite. San Antonio's top country artist which contains one of the Cosmic Cowboy's and my favourite tracks the impossibly catchy "If This Was Texas". This is on the Bill Green label or should I say was as it is impossible to find. He covers a number of styles with great versions of Ian Tyson's "Navajo Rug" plus one of the last songs that hit for Lefty, "Honky Tonk Stardust Cowboy". A wonderful album. Had a few but genuinely down to 1 only.

Morse, Ella Mae Capitol Collectors Series \$25 21 tracks with a big band R & B flavour but also country. Best ever "Cow Cow Boogie"!!

Nelson, Leo Under Neon Lights \$45 Want to know my all time favourite independent, yeah not one of but *the* top spot?? This is it. Great album produced by Bob Grady with assist from the great Mike Headrick. 12 great tracks with a duet with Bill Arwood on the title track. I think on reflection a 3 way tie with Ron Sweet and Arnold Sanford is in order. Alas both Ron & Arnold have gone and heaven knows where Leo is?? To me the jewel is how easy Leo sings. Marsha Britton contributes harmony vocals. Favourite tracks? Start at the beginning and stop at the end. BUT, if pushed "Mama Did Raise One Fool After All" and "Under Neon Light", the duet with Bill Arwood are superb.

Nelson, Willie "Peace in the Valley: The Gospel Truth Collection with Willie Nelson Jnr." \$50 They used a little poetic licence with the artists as Willie Nelson Jnr was known only as Billy Nelson all his life, up until it tragically ended on Christmas day 1991. So this album had special meaning for Willie as it seems this was the only time Willie Jnr/Billy had recorded. The results are stunning. Billy/Willie Jnr generally trades parts of the songs with Willie and has a distinctive voice that is instantly memorable. He does the sole vocal on "My Body's Just a Suitcase for Your Soul" and it indeed may be the best track on an album where nothing is less than grand. Willie solos on "Troublemaker" and it is a different and far better version than on his album of the same name. Being a big Willie fan I must rate this as his best gospel album an indeed one of the best in general. It was only ever an independent and was released in 1994...despite the Volume 1 added to the title there has never been another. It is incredibly rare. Buy it on Amazon...but only if you want to pay \$100.

Nelson, Willie "The Promiseland" \$30 Is headed by David Lynn Jones great "Living in the Promiseland" and also sees Willie steer away from his own songs, although he does a brilliant full country version of his "I'm Not Trying to Forget You". As a special treat he does a wonderful guitar version of a Bach minuet...the one that the pop group The Toys called The Lover's Concerto.

Nolan, Bob "The Sound of a Pioneer" \$35 Garrett label. Bob Nolan retired from the Sons of the Pioneers in the 50s and did little, seemingly, in the period up to the release of this album in the late 70s. As such it was a surprise and a gem all in one as his distinctive voice had seemingly not altered in the slightest and the production by Snuff Garrett was first class. It has some great gospel including "The Man Walks Among Us" which features Marty Robbins. Alas Bob only lived a little while after this album...as did Marty unfortunately. Don't miss the cd version as it is very hard to get.

O'Kanes O'Kanes \$30 Their stunning debut with classics "Oh Darlin'" and the bluegrass like romp "Oh Lonesome You". Long long deleted.

O'Kanes Tired of the Running \$25 Second album from Keiran Kane & Jamie O'Hara is also hardest to get. Blind accordionist Jay Spell is superb.

Oxford, David David Oxford \$55 There has only been one and there appears to be little chance of another, but despite hope being minimal there is still some hope. This is superb with a mix of honky tonk, cryin' in beer ballads and just plain great songs "'1-800 Wine" is pure honky tonk whilst the Cosmic Cowboy, a sentimental old fluff if ever there was one, closes his annual community radio father's day show with Oxford's "Don't Tell the Babies". As far as production goes this is stunning. The great Bobby Flores is present throughout. And Michael Morales who apparently performed strictly in a Spanish market is great on acoustic guitar. David had talks with major labels apparently but was disillusioned when he was told he didn't have the right image. Damn, why didn't he get angry and produce a box set. Even that would not be enough. A gem gem gem!!

Oxford, Vernon Let Me Sing You a Song: The 1960s RCA Recordings \$45

Westside UK out of print gem with a whopping 28 tracks. These are on Bear Family box but that may be a bit too much for some. This is just about perfect.

Ritter, Tex - Capitol Collectors Series \$35 Out of print series, of which I would recommend with every title as being essential. This has all the hard to get ones, "Deck of Cards", "Blood on the Saddle" & "Just Beyond the Moon" etc 25 in all. .

Rodriguez, Johnny Gracias! \$35 Fabulous album on Capitol. Released late 80s and included his last charting single, "I Didn't Every Chance That I Had". Great bunch of backing musicians including Pig Robbins on piano and Sonny Garrish on steel. Very hard to get now.

Ryle, Curt Life Time Guarantee \$35 What can you say but Curt is a true indie artist, amazing talent, superb writer and singer but with the dress sense God gave a goat. But it is not that latter thing which matters & on the former he delivers. He wrote the superb "Mirrors Don't Lie" & his own version loses nothing in comparison to that Gene Watson. Curt wrote 9 of the 11 on this gem. And he has a superb style...that is vocal not dress, which he can certainly not lay claim to!!

Schneider, John "Take the Long Way Home" MCA \$35

Despite a some what goofy persona due his role in Dukes of Hazard, Schneider had a wonderful deep voice which was a natural for country music. All are superbly produced by Jimmy Bowen. A wonderful highlight is, "Better Class of Losers", not to be confused with the Alan Jackson track of the name. This is the Harlan Howard track which features none other than Waylon Jennings and Johnny Cash. BUT believe it or not, even better is "The Auction"...they're auctioning daddy's farm today. Hell it is hard to believe how good, and in view of the diabolical financial system in the US today it is still extremely relevant.

Scott, Jack Capitol Collectors Series \$35 Fabulous 23 tracker with a mix of upbeat and ballads. Even has 4 unreleased tracks. As far as the ballads go none is better than "What in the World's Come Over You" (with the delightful break between the first and second word) and "Burning Bridges". A very much underappreciated artist. Everyone should have this cd in their collection, Nice touch is the inclusion of some studio talk at the beginning of some tracks.

Shearer, Charlie "Breakin' Out" \$30 A gem again with production by the very talented Curt Ryle and also wrote quite a few of the songs. So good in fact that Mike Headrick would be proud of this one!! He begins with a great shuffle version of Willie's "I Just Destroyed the World" and then follows with a big Curt Ryle ballad "History Repeats Itself". Originally from Texas...this is just how it should be.

Simpson, Red "Best of Red Simpson: Country Western Truck Drivin' Singer" Razor & Tie \$28

20 tracks with great wit and style...as all truckin' albums should be. A major influence for Junior Brown. Includes all his big hits such as "Highway Patrol" (one of Junior's best as well), "Nitro Express" and "I'm a Truck", the very clever song which has the truck telling the story.

Simpson, Red "The Man Behind the Badge/ Roll Truck Roll" \$35 EMI UK 2 on 1 with 2 albums from 1966. "Motivatin' Man" was actually picked up and recorded by John Laws but don't hold that against Red.

Springfield, Bobby Lee All Fired Up \$30 An absolute ripsnorter. Crazed man who apparently got arrested for climbing over the White House fence in order to visit the President, presumably Ronny Regan. But his honky tonk style which includes the original "Hank Drank" is grand. Also includes a brilliant version of Eddy Arnold's "What's He Doing in My World" with intro by Eddy himself!!

Sweet, Ron Ten in Tennessee \$45 Another wonderful indie with the highlight the wonderful odeto the great man "I Play Haggard" in which he uses snippets of Haggard songs to tell the story. He outdoes even Vern Gosdin on his version "Baby That's Cold" and then shows himself a man for all seasons with the rollicking "Ten in Tennessee".

Thompson, Jeff Jeff Thompson \$30 No, not that Thommo, but a fine singer who was going to have the first album release on the Arista country label but the album never came out. Has a style reminiscent of Ricky Van Shelton with a great deep voice. Does a superb version of "The Greatest Man I Never Knew", a hit for Reba, but Jeff wins hands down!! Equally grand is the wonderful "It's a Good Thing I Don't Love You Anymore", with a superb lyric and the upbeat "Today is Elvis' Birthday".

Turner, Zeb Tennessee Boogie & Jersey Rock \$30 King label anthology 1949-1953. On the now defunct Westside label. 24 tracks.

Wagoner, Porter Greatest Hits \$30 20 tracker with great and unusual selection including of course "Rubber Room" but also "What Would You Do, If Jesus Came to Your House")

Wall, Chris "Honky Tonk Heart" Ryko \$30 His debut album originally released as a cassette only job on Tried & True Records in 1989 and issued on cd on Rykodisc in 1990. Not to be missed. It includes his version of "Trashy Women" but the modern day play of

words on "I Wish John Stetson Had a Heart" gives the album its true character. Great. Don't miss his new album!

Watson, Gene The Good Old days \$25 Step One with a superb selection excellently produced by Ray Pennington who also contributed 4 Songs. Like all Step One releases this is out of print.

Whitley, Keith I Wonder Do You Think of Me \$30 The album he had just finished when he died. One of the greatest ever country vocalists. Deep rich voice with his own nuances. Pity the wonderful honky tonk songs were lived out so tragically with his alcohol overdose. He was seemingly taking over from Randy Travis as country's premier vocalist and had the unheard of 5 number one country singles in a row.

Young, Faron Live Fast Love Hard: Original Capitol Classics 1952-1962 \$28 Country Music Foundation label. 24 tracks with excellent presentation.

Big Rig Hits Truck Driver's Boogie 1939-69 \$35 A great cd which encapsulates a history of that great sub-genre the trucking song. Compiled jointly by CMF & Diesel only records. First is "Truck Driver's Blues" by Cliff Bruner with Moon Mullican on vocals. Classic's such as Terry Fell's "Truck Driving man" are featured with rarities such as Curtis Leach's amazing "Highway Man". One of the best compilations ever.

Laine, Frankie

That Lucky Old Sun (sealed box) \$150 6cds + picture disc+hard cover book. Again the word versatility comes to mind but Frankie was mainly a pop singer who did some great country material. This includes "Mule Train" and covers his formative period 1944-1951. It features his duets with the equally diverse Patti Page. Many unissued songs.

Laine, Frankie

I Believe (sealed box) \$140 6cds + hard cover book. This covers his early Columbia Recordings from 1951 to 1955 and has mammoth hits "Jezebel", the title cut and of course "High Noon"...a huge hit for Frankie even though Tex Ritter did it in the movie. It includes his duets with Doris Day, Jo Stafford, the Four Lads & probably the greatest child vocalist ever in Jimmy Boyd....well I loved Jimmy anyway!!

Locklin, Hank

Send Me the Pillow You Dream On 3 cd + 32 pg Decca/ 4-Star etc (pre RCA) \$70. This covers the period 1948 to 1955 and has his original version of the title track. As well as 65 others.

Monroe, Bill

Bluegrass 1959-1969 4cd + 28 pg book \$80 120 tracks with a multitude of backing musicians who essentially were forever changing...suggesting Monroe must have been hard to work for. Includes Peter Rowan, Roland White, Benny Martin, Kenny Baker etc.

Pierce, Webb

Nashville RCA studio was perhaps the best ever. Rarely available except as brand new and then that is over \$500

Robbins, Marty

Country 1960-1966 4 cd + book \$100. Marty's boxes are perhaps the most popular Bear Family boxes we have ever sold and good reason...there is simply not a bad song and Marty is perhaps the most versatile popcalist in all country music history with an ear for a great song...many of course he wrote. One of the biggest, "Devil Woman" is featured on this set. His fabulous gospel album "What God Has Done" is included here.

Snow, Hank

Singing Ranger Vol 1 4cd + 16 pg book \$80 Hank's first US recordings and what a start with his signature "I'm Movin' On". Has his first duets with Anita Carter including the wonderful "Bluebird Island" and of course it wouldn't be a Hank album without a tearjerker such as the original version of "Nobody's Child".

Snow, Hank

Thesaurus Transcriptions 5 cd + 40 pg book \$100 couple small marks on box. These tracks were recorded for radio broadcast and are not on any other Hank Snow album. Sound is excellent. Around 6 hours worth!!

Walker, Billy

Cross the Brazos at Waco 5 cds + book \$120 One of the most versatile country singers...a little like stable mate, Marty Robbins. Each cd has a title and each runs a shade under 80 minutes. 1)Walking the Long Miles: Muswell Hill To LA 2) Finding Better Words: The Essential Richard Thompson 3) Shiner in the Dark: the Epic Live Workshops 4)The Song PPOur Down Like Silver: The Covers & Sessions 5) Real Rarities and the 6th CD NOT available ..Richard Thompson on the Free Reed label. Also has a booklet about the Vincent, the subject of perhaps his best known song. This is as new....have a sealed copy for \$same price but it won't have the 6th cd....but still may be write in. It also doesn't cross into the territory of the following box, at all!!!
- Thompson, Richard** **"Walking on a Wire 1968-2009" \$60** 4cds sealed Shout Factory label.71 classic recordings which covers his solo career as well as Fairport Convention as well as duet recordings with ex wife Linda Thompson. Includes 60 page book all in attractive box.
- Torme, Mel** **The Collection 1944-1985 Rhino 4cd + 64 page book. \$40** I'd tend to classify Mel more in the jazz category but then again many are on the look out for his version of "Cast Your Fate to the Wind" which is available one place and one place only and that is on this set. 89 tracks. As new.
- Turner, Tina** **Collected Recordings Sixties to Nineties 3cds \$40** Very attractive 84 page colour book. Long Style box in Pristine condition. Covers her early career with then then husband Ike through to her period as the super star supreme. Very attractive box with gold Tina!!
- Velvet Underground** **Peel Slowly & See 5cd + 88 page book \$58** In absolutely pristine condition. 75 tracks including rarities.

Andy Warhol's famous peelable banana adorns the cover.
Lots of previously unreleased tracks.

- Wainwright, Loudon III** **"40 Odd Years" \$60** sealed 4 cds + DVD. 69 songs from 25 albums plus as additional 22 rare and unreleased tracks. The DVD contains a 60 minute documentary "One Man Guy" plus a bunch of live performances bringing the dvd time to around 200 minutes. A clever and humorous artist who has been married to one of the McGarrigles and one of the Roches. Great box. Fans will immediately know what the song titles "IDTTYWLM" and the very politically incorrect "IWIWAL" expand to.
- Waters, Muddy** **The King of Chicago Blues \$48 4cd+ 44 pg book**
This is a nice book style box which has 96 tracks . The 4 cds run for over 5 hours each have a separate title. Hits & Inspirations/ Some Roots Recycled/ They Call Me Muddy ` Waters & Muddy Rocks Out.
- White, Barry** **Just for You 3cds \$30 + 32 page** . Includes work with Love Unlimited Orch. Quincy Jones, Isaac Hayes & solo. Nice long box style package.
- Who** **Singles Box \$45** Out of print box from Polydor which contains 12cds, a& b sides which replicate the original 45 packaging and includes 2 new recordings and a 16 page booklet.
- Winwood, Steve** **"The Finer things" 4 cds + 48 page book.** Great career spanning box covering his tenure with Spencer Davis Group, Traffic, Blind Faith and of course solo **\$45**
- XTC** **Coat of Many Cupboards 4 cds of rarities. \$55** Long style box with 80 page book.Out of print. As new.
- Yankovic, Weird Al** **Permanent Record 4cds \$50 + 60 page book.** This is long out of print. Al has been around for a long time and that is due fact he is genuinely funny and clever
- Young, Neil** **"Official Release Series Discs 1-4" 24 K Gold LIMITED edition. \$110** These may have been included in the country section. DO NOT CONFUSE THIS WITH THE STANDARD JEWEL CASE EDITION sold in Australia. These are gold discs a la Mobile Fidelity. They are genuine gold, which gives better sound as the laser is able to read more of the encoded signal. BTW, some discs claim to be gold but are merely gold covered. If you have a disc claiming to be a gold limited edition you can see if it is real by holding up to your eye. You can actually see through the real ones. These ARE real. They also replicate the packaging of the original lps with double fold covers and inserts. These are also numbered editions has Neil Young/ Everybody Knows This is Nowhere/ After the Goldrush (his best)/ Harvest (his biggest seller). Incidentally an Australian release of a later Neil Young album, "Harvest Moon" purports to have a gold disc but in that case it is gold colour only.

- Zombie** **Zombie Heaven 4cds + 72 pg book Ace UK \$55** From their early hit "She's Not There" through their classic album "Odessey & Oracle" and their subsequent career revitalisation with "Time of the Season", a surprise US number 1. Colin Blunstone & Rod Argent were the leaders.
- ZZ Top** **"Chrome Smoke & Barbecue" \$80** Rhino still sealed This is out of print and hard to get. It includes an 88 page book plus a flip book...this is the one where you flip through the pages and it looks like a movie. Contains 80 tracks. This is the special edition in the shape of a Texas Roadshack replete with corrugated iron roof. Well it looks like corrugated iron. Also includes figures of the band and a bbq table set with the finest!! "La Grange" is a superb track.
- VARIOUS**
- Atlantic Vocal Groups** **1951-1963 4cds + book \$45** Great companion to the previous cd 12"x12" box on the limited edition Rhino Handmade label 82 tracks including some absolute rarities,
- Beat Generation** **Rhino 3cds + 60 page book. \$50** The beatnik generation featuring Jack Kerouac, Allan Ginsberg, Lord Buckley etc, as well as songs including the king of the 50s tv hipsters, Ed Kookie Byrnes and "Kookie's Mad Pad". As you may expect there is a Tom Waits song and Maynard G Krebs gets referenced in the book.
- Brain in a Box** **The Science Fiction Section 5cds + 200 page hardcover book \$110** Rhino's most eccentric box and that is really saying something. Each cd has a theme. Movie themes/ TV Themes/ Pop/ Incidental lounge/ Novelty. Has a fabulous 3d cover of....a brain in a box. Very collectable now.
- Various "Broadside:** **Best of Broadside 1962-1988" \$60** Smithsonian Folkways. Great package. The 5cds running a tad under 5 and a half hours are housed in a a 160 page spiral bound book which fits inside a neat hard slip case. Each of the **89** songs has its own page. Great artists including known and unknowns..."Blind Boy Grunt" may be better known as Bob Dylan but did you know that Janis Ian was Blind Girl Grunnt!! Also Phil Ochs, Pete Seeger, Peter Lafarge, Tom Paxton, Malvina Reynolds, Richard Farina etc. Broadside are classified as "topical songs" but may be called "protest songs". Each entry includes song lyrics and discographical details. An essential set in my mind for anyone who likes any of the artists mentioned above Fabulous box.
- Complete Norman Granz** **Jam Sessions 5cds in Metal framed case with 72 pg book. \$60** Norman Granz was the man behind Verve Records and began a series of all star concerts which were originally held at the Philharmonic Hall in Los Angeles. Soon he took these tours on the road but they still were known as "Jazz at the Philharmonic". This set collects some of the best long jams recorded between 1952 and 1954. Sound is superb, something Verve was famous for. Among those on

this are Dizzy Gillespie, Benny Carter, Charlie Parker, Stan Getz, Illinois Jacquet, Oscar Peterson, Count Basie, Herb Ellis, Buddy Rich etc etc, soem tracks go for nearly 20 minutes. The solos are all handed round and then the central theme is replayed. These are great. The sound is spectacular

Doctors:Professors:

Kings & Queens The Big Ol' Box of new Orleans" 4cd 84 page book on Shout Factory Over 5 hours featuring the likes of Fats Domino, Dr John, Professor Longhair, Lloyd Price, Buckwheat Zydeco plus a lot you've never heard of etc **\$60**. Sealed 85 tracks.

Doo Wop Box 3

\$70 Rhino Out of print. One and Two are also out of print but 3 is already the hardest to get. Interesting that the 4 cds each have a theme. The Hits/ Should Have Been Hits/ Celebrity Picks/ Modern Doo Wop. Celebrity pickers include Dion (perhaps the greatest white doo-wopper), Leiber & Stoller...Robert Plant & Keith Richards!!! 101 tracks

Loud fast & Out of Control

The Wild Sounds of 50's Rock Rhino \$100 4cds + 88 page book which is as much about pop culture as the music. This is another classic out of print set. 104 tracks. It does feature a lot of the better known artists but no one presents them like Rhino. Out of print.

Finding Their Voice

Century of Recorded Poetry Rhino 4cds \$40 This almost needs its own category as it features poets and beat poets so guess a natural to go with the preceding "Beat Generation" box 52 page hard cover book.

Forever Changing

The Golden Age of Elektra Records 1963-1973 \$60 Excellent 5cd history of Elektra Records which includes a stunning 76 page book with a track by track rundown. For a label that started as a folk label with the likes of Judy Collins, Bob Gibson and co it quickly developed with rock legends The Doors, blues rock of Paul Butterfield and co co-existing with the protest singers Tom Paxton and Phil Ochs. Lots of rarities which make it even more appealing. Each song, all 117 of them has its own separate entry in the wonderful book New & sealed. Naturally a brilliant Rhino label offering.

Harry Smith Project

Revisited \$50 2cds + 2 DVDs + 40 page book. Harry Smith's original set is generally accepted as the definitive collection of American folk music and this features modern performers doing 30th and 40s songs eg Steve Earle does "Prison Cell Blues" originally performed by Blind Lemon Jefferson in 1928 & on the Blind Lemon track...Lou Reed does "See My Grave Is Kept Clean"

Have a Nice Decade

The 70s Pop Culture Box \$90 160 tracks over 7 cds ...the best from Rhino's Have a Nice Day series. What sets this apart is two fold...great book and secondly the box is covered with **real** carpet complete with a smiley face. Yep, you better believe it.

- Hot Rods & Custom Classics Rhino \$100** This is an out of print box in absolutely as new condition and includes all the extras. 4cds + 68 page book, plus additional book...fluffy dice to hang from the rear view mirror, transfers etc. Every imaginable song about drag racing and hot rods is included. And the presentation will have you smiling from ear to ear.
- Long Road to Freedom: An Anthology of Black Music BMG Legacy \$60**
Amazing project under the direction of Harry Belafonte. 5 cds + DVD + 140 page clothbound hard cover book. Various themes are explored: The Roots / Shouts & Early Spirituals/ Louisiana Creole/ Slave Christmas/ Underground Railroad/ The War/ Country Moods/ City Moods/ Ballads & Frolics/ Bad Men, Booze & Minstrels/ Muscle & Sweat & My God is a Rock. Box is approx. 30cm x 23cm x 6cm. Small split on top of box. All as new otherwise.
- Mercury Blues 'N Rhythm Story 1945-1955 Mercury** Very hard to get out of print box. 8 cds 88 page book and 211 tracks, This is a long style box with a very attractive gilt edging. Artists include Jay McShann, Johnny Otis, Buddy Johnson, Dinah Washington, Jay Hawkins, Big Bill Broonzy etc **\$100** This is pristine as it gets
- Midwinter A Celebration of the Folk Music of Christmas & the Turning of the Year \$70** The Christmas box to end all Christmas boxes. Avoids any of the standards and has an amazing 140 page book which details every song. It covers all number of artists from John Fahey, Richard Farina with Bob Dylan on "Xmas Island" (yep the title is spelt that way) through to John Prine, Jethro tull, Loudon Wainwright III and the Strawbs. From the fabulous Free Reed label.
- Monterey International Pop Festival \$48.** Includes many artists who were at Woodstock such as Country Joe & the Fish, the Who and the show stealer (for both) Jim Hendrix. Also features Byrds, Butterfield Blues Band, Booker T & MGS Otis Redding (he was extraordinary) etc This is 4cds in jewel case in a hard cardboard box with 24 page booklet.
- NUGGETS SERIES (all Rhino)**
Love Is The Song We Sing: San Francisco Nuggets 1965-1970 \$60 29 x 23 cm
Bound book style Nice matte style with silver writing. The cds are included in a special slip in slot in the book, which is 120 pages with rare photos of all the artists so famed in the San Francisco area. Includes 77 tracks by the well known (Grass Roots/ Country Joe & the Fish/ Beau Brummels/ Janis Joplin) through the semi knowns and then the real rarities.
Great series.
- Nuggets Original Artyfacts from the First Psychedelia Era Rhino \$80.** Sealed box 91 garage rock tracks with 100 page book. Classic box set.
- Nuggets II Original Artyfacts from the British Empire & Beyond Rhino \$100** This is as new. It is very rare now. Do a check. Has great 100 page book and has a few iconic Australian tracks in the mix. Classic series.

- Where the Action Is** **Los Angeles Nuggets 1965-1968 \$60 29 x 23 cm**
Sunset Strip revisited with The Doors, Buffalo Springfield, Electric Prunes, Lee Hazelwood, Byrds, Tim Buckley etc 48 page hard bond book package. Like all in this series, an absolute must.
- RESPECT:** **A History of Women in Music Rhino 5cd + 84 pg book all in a delightful velvet/felt covered box \$60** . Each cd has a specific theme:
1. Broadway, Blues & the Truth
 2. Torch, Twang & Swing
 3. Shoop, Shoop, Motown, Get Down
 4. Rock to Electric Shock
 5. Hip hop, Pop & Passion.
- Also includes 7 postcards suitable for framing....all in A Picasso style by Christine Haberstock.
- Rock & Skiffle** **Brit Beat begins 4cdfs (Proper) \$20** 40 page book And 100 tracks from Donegan (natch!!)/ Tommy Steele/ Vipers/ Ken Colyer/ even a track of the Goons and some Winifred Atwell. Last copy
- Say it Loud** **A Celebration of Black Music in America Rhino \$60**
Real steal. 6 cds + 76 page book, includes blues, soul ,a bit of jazz, a bit of country, rock etc all interspersed with short speeches which define the rise to equality and the horrible notion of racism. So it is also an historical document. Some tracks are *really* hardline such as James Brown "" Say it Loud: I'm Black & I'm Proud" and Sly Stone "Don't Call Mr Nigger Whitey". Wow!!
- Testify:** **The Gospel Box \$55 Rhino**
Wonderful set of black gospel by the best US proponent of the box set. Features a red cover hard book like structure which brilliantly looks exactly like a bible, complete with gold leaf pages. Includes 52 pg book. 50 tracks.
- The Transports** **The Full Story of the First Fleet Transported to Australia 1787-88 and the classic Ballad Opera That it Inspired \$60** As much a historic document. This has the original 1977 album which Melody Maker voted "Folk Album of the Year". There is a 132 page book describing the history of the First Fleet and of the English Transported Convicts, a full discography and a full discography of the 1977 and 2004 versions. Both are the product of Peter Bellamy, a mainstay of the English Folk scene and feature mainstays of the British Folk scene....Peter Bellamy, AMrtin Carthy, Fairport Convention, Simon Nicol, June Tabor, Steve Tilston, Norma Waterson to name but a few.
- Vee Jay** **Celebrating 40 Years of Classic Hits 1953-1993 75 tracks \$58** Nice cloth bound box with Gold lettering. 3 cds + 24 page book plus a 7" 45 repro of the Spaniels "Goodnite Sweetheart" on red vinyl. \$58 Sealed copy
- Washington Square** **Memoirs:The Great Urban Folk Boom 1950-1970 \$60**
Great Rhino book style box with 72 page book which gives a

track by track run down of the 72 songs, Includes rarities like Bonnie Dobson performing her oft-covered "Morning Dew" and Fred Neil's similarly covered "The Dolphins". Nice bookend work...starts with Woody and ends with Arlo...that's Guthrie's boy. Wonderful.

3 Days of Peace & Music \$80 This is the 6 cds version which contains many many recordings that didn't make it to the original album such as Creedence Clearwater Revival, Tim Hardin, Johnny Winter etc. Also has an excellent 80 page book with many hitherto unseen photographs. Attractive red bookstyle box.

Woodstock Experience

Box Rhino 10 cds \$90 This is a very rare item in that only a few of the boxes were released. The cds in the box (5 x 2cd sets) were released separately. The set consists of performances at the Woodstock Festival each 2cds set having another famous album by the artist (Shown in brackets) plus a poster. So with the Woodstock performances of each you get the following:

1. Jefferson Airplane (Volunteers)
2. Johnny Winter (Johnny Winter)
3. Sly & the Family Stone (Stand)
4. Santana (Santana)
5. Janis Joplin (Kosmik Blues)

The additional albums are all in nice mini lp repro covers. Apart from the poster you get in each 2cd box you also get a Woodstock poster. Great...betcha 2 Woodstocks on that!

WOW!

That Was the 70s \$28 8 cds with 7 ½ hours of music from EMI Holland. Comes in a nifty flip top box. Lots of one hit wonders and all styles intertwine perfectly. Disky put out some great boxes.

King of Cool: The Best of the Dean Martin Variety Show 6DVDs 10 hrs \$45 Time Life The guest list includes stars such as Ella Fitzgerald, Eddie Fisher, Liberace, Herb Alper etc. Sealed

Woodstock Deluxe edition \$48 4 dvds...double the length of the movie. Reprint of the Life Magazine issue that covered the festival...68 pages...Glass holograph...Special Ultimate Collector's Edition Box.
